Standard Preparation for **Colonoscopy Exam Golytely/Colyte Solution**

You have been given a prescription for one container of either Golytely or Colyte Laxative. This agent comes in powder form and must be diluted with bottled water before you take the laxative. Follow the directions on the container for diluting the powder. Shake well to dissolve the powder completely then keep the container of laxative solution in the refrigerator. **Do not mix more than 2 days before your procedure.**

Directions for taking Golytely/Colyte Prep:

1. **Start your prep at 1 pm on the day before your exam.** Drink one 8-ounce glass of the solution every 15 minutes until the total amount is taken.
2. You must stay on a **clear liquid diet** for the entire day before the procedure (Clear broth, jello, Gatorade, apple juice, water, ginger ale, etc). Do not take red liquids. **Do not eat or drink anything by mouth after midnight before your procedure.**
3. You may take your heart medications and blood pressure medications with a small sip of water on the day of the exam.
4. If you are a diabetic your Doctor will review your medication instructions.
5. Stop Coumadin 5 days before the exam. Stop Aspirin and Aspirin containing products on the **attached list** 7 days before the procedure.
6. You must have someone accompany you to and from the procedure. You are prohibited from driving until 24 hours after the procedure. This is for your protection and the protection of others since the medications used before and during the procedure may cause you to still feel relaxed or sedated after the exam.

Stop all medications on list starting **7 days** before your colonoscopy and/or endoscopy procedure.
Stop Coumadin **5 days** before your procedure.
